

KEY FINDINGS FROM COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

HELD ON 14TH FEBRUARY 2009

These key findings will be considered when developing the Masterplan for the site

1. TRAFFIC /TRANSPORT

- a. There will be resistance to any proposal to put traffic lights at the junction of Bishopthorpe Road and Campleshon Road.
- b. The proposals must include information on how potential displacement parking to the surrounding streets will be addressed.
- c. A better bus service is required.

2. EXISTING CAR PARK

- a. The building of an Hotel on this area of green belt will not be well received.

3. THE BUND

- a. There is significant support for the removal or penetration of this feature to improve connectivity to the surrounding area

4. CYCLING

- a. Proposals should include for the enhancement of the cycle route down to the river.

5. SITE USES

- a. There are varied observations and comments regarding uses.
- b. Housing to the North of the site is considered appropriate.
- c. Community facilities and small shops are OK.
- d. Galleries / Exhibition space and cafes all had strong support.
- e. A swimming pool also featured quite strongly in requests.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. The concept of smaller public spaces, with linked routes, found favour.
